D a n n y Armstrong, running like a floorboarded bulldozer pumped and stomped his way for 212 yards in carries to lead the MacArthur Brahmas past the Jefferson Mustangs, 28-14, Friday night before 2,712 fans at North East Stadium.



One of those carries by the

ound senior was a 95-yard touchdown run in the second quarter which turned the complexion of the game permanent blue and white. He also scored on a 22-yard jaunt in the closing minutes.

After an uneventful first quarter, Jefferson drew first blood when quarterback Tom-

son engineered a 76-

yard drive in 10 plays, capped

by a 28-yard scoring pass to

Rocky Thompson who got be-

hind defenders Fred Hudson

and Gary Catchings on a per-

fectly executed stop and go pat-

tern. Thompson also added the

point after.

The Brahmas then drove to

the Mustang 25 yard line, where

Armstrong fumbled to Mike

Glofa. Thompson stopped another

MacArthur drive with an in-

terception on the Mustang 47.

Seconds later, George Henderson

went tit for tat with a steal

of Tommy Thompson's pass on

the Brahma five-yard-line.

On the next play, Jefferson

punched its defenders up close,

and Armstrong shot out of the

backfield like a Brahma out of

a chute, churning 95 yards with-

out being seriously challenged.

Still puffing for air, he kicked

MacArthur into a 7-7 tie.

Late in the second quarter,

the Brahmas struck again fol-

lowing an interception by Eric

Ehninger on the Mustange 44.

George Henderson did the hon-

ors from four yards out and

Armstrong added another with

his toe.

Following a scoreless third

quarter, MacArthur appeared to

put the game on ice with a 70

yard drive climaxed by quarter-

back Brad Wheelless' one-yard

scoring run. The point after

snap was fumbled to keep the

score at 20-7.

The Mustangs roared back

with Tommy Thompson slinging

and Jaime Garza and Mike

Smith catching. Garza hauled in

a two-yard pass to complete the

drive and Rocky Thompson's

foot brought the Mustangs with-

in six.

Minutes later Armstrong

roared over from the Jeff 22

trampling Mustangs en route to

put the icing on the cake
