MacArthur Boots Unicorns

The MacArthur Brahmas shocked New Braunfels with 27 points in the second half to blitz the youthful Unicorns 34-15 Saturday night in a District 29-A A A A skirmish at North East Stadium as 2,077 cold and windswept fans watched.

Coach Bill Hooper's brigade unleashed its version of the dynamite duo, fullback Danny Armstrong and halfback George Henderson, to quickly

erase an 8-7 halftime deficit.

Before the final gun, Henderson had scored on an eight yard run, Armstrong had crossed the Unicorn goal line from the three, end Kevin Vinall latched on to a 29-yard scoring pass from quarterback Brad Wheelless, and defensive back Marc Owens sailed 31 yards for a touchdown unmolested with an errant New Braunfels pass.

Vinall caught a conversion pass from Wheelless following his TD and Armstrong booted a point after Owens' six-pointer.

The Brahmas took a 7-0 lead in the second quarter when Armstrong capped a short 26-yard push with a one-yard run. Armstrong added the point. Defensive back Jeff Large inter-

cepted a pass at the 26 to set up the touchdown.

New Braunfels bounced back late in the second period when fullback David Arnold bulled over from the one with 5:33 left in the half. Arnold ran the two-point conversion on a fake-kick formation to cap the 58-yard, 13-play march and give the Unicorns a brief edge.

The Unicorns scored their final touchdown in the fourth pe-

riod. Following a short punt, New Braunfels was in business at the Brahma 30. Three plays later, sophomore quarterback Gary Bob Smith lofted a 10-yard scoring aerial to end Kent Lohman. Rocky Hill kicked the conversion.

Henderson rushed for 119 yards in 11 attempts and Armstrong totaled 111 yards in 23 totes for MacArthur, which is 1-2-1 in district and 4-4-1 on the year. Halfback Mark Smith finished with 61 yards in 14 carries and Gary Smith, intercepted thrice, passed for 113 yards on 10 to 18 passes for the Unicorns.
